Kihonido: Basics with Linear Motion

Sanchin Dachi

- 1. Seiken Tsuki, Sanchin Dachi (Front Punch)
- 2. Seiken Tsuki, Mae Geri, Sanchin Dachi (Front Punch, Front Thrust Kick)

Zenkutsu Dachi

- 1. Zenkutsu Dachi, Oi Tsuki (Lunge Punch)
- 2. Mae Geri, Zenkutsu Dachi (Front Thrust Kick)
- 3. Zenkutsu Dachi, Hiji Ate (Elbow Strike)
- 4. Mawashi Geri, Zenkutsu Dachi (Roundhouse Kick)
- 5. Zenkutsu Dachi, Shuto Uchi (Knife-Hand Strike)

Kihonido are said in the order in which they are performed!

Techniques in

Shiko Dachi

- 1. 45° Shiko Dachi, Haraiotoshi Uke (Downward Sweeping Block)
- 2. 45° Shiko Dachi, Oi Tsuki (Lunge Punch)
- 3. 45° Shiko Dachi, Fura Uchi (Whipping Strike)
- 4. 45° Shiko Dachi, Te Uke, Shita Tsuki (Palm Block, Short Punch)
- 5. 45° Shiko Dachi, Haraiotoshi Uke, transition to Zenkutsu Dachi, Gyaku Tsuki (*Downward Sweeping Block, Reverse Punch*)

6. 45° Shiko Dachi, Mawashi Hiji Ate, Ura Ken, Tetsui, Gyaku Tsuki (Roundhouse Elbow Strike, Backfist, Hammer-Fist Strike, Reverse Punch)

Kumite

- Kumite (sparring) must be supervised by a Dan-rank (adult Black Belt) instructor.
- Appropriate safety gear must be worn. All sparring gear should be purchased through the dojo.
- **Light contact only**. No contact to head, throat, spine or groin.
- Take downs and throws are prohibited.
- Blind, swinging techniques will not be tolerated.
- Students are not permitted to spar with students of other schools (except at approved tournaments and seminars).

Referee Signals & Terminology

- Point (Ippon): Hand extended directly to side.
- Out of Bounds (*Jogai*): Hand extended downward and to side.
- Illegal Contact Verbal Warning (Atenayone): Hand raised.
- Illegal Contact Point Awarded (Hansoku Chui): Hand raised.
- Illegal Contact Disqualification (Shikaku): Hand raised, circling.
- Unsure/Did not see: Hands crossed in front of face.
- No Point/Penalty: Hands crossed in front, low.
- **Conflicting Points**: Fists facing in towards each other.

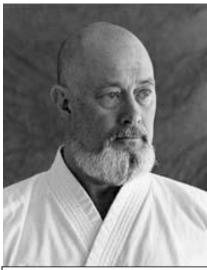
